To All Hunt Cars, Quads and Motorbikes

Large numbers of vehicles follow the staghounds, almost always on inadequate roads; therefore please ensure that the following rules are observed.

DON'T	DO
Park on both sides of the road, even if it means looking the "wrong way".	Make every effort to speed the passage of non-hunting vehicles, particularly lorries and buses.
Park in drives, lanes or gateways which may be needed for horses, farm or other traffic.	Help anyone trying to clear a jam.
Drive on private land without the landowner's permission.	Switch off your engine whenever there is a hold up.
Try and beat hounds to the next crossing place.	Observe the highway code and be considerate of all other road users.
Park where deer may break out into the open.	Remember that the behaviour of hunting traffic leaves a lasting impression with non hunting people.
Get involved in physical contact with Saboteurs/Monitors.	Take a note of the registration of any monitors/saboteurs' vehicles. Inform the Masters of their presence and if possible film/photograph them.

We welcome all followers provided they observe the above rules and show courtesy to other road users who may not be following the Hunt.
